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SmartEd AI Learning Platform Successfully Piloted Across Europe

Virtual Piloting of IO3 Brings Together More Than 200 Educators

The SmartEd project has successfully completed the virtual piloting of its IO3 – SmartEd AI Learning Platform. The piloting took place between 18 May and 12 June 2026 and involved teachers from Lithuania, Türkiye, Croatia, Cyprus, Greece, Italy, and Romania.

A total of 206 educators participated in the piloting activities and evaluation process.

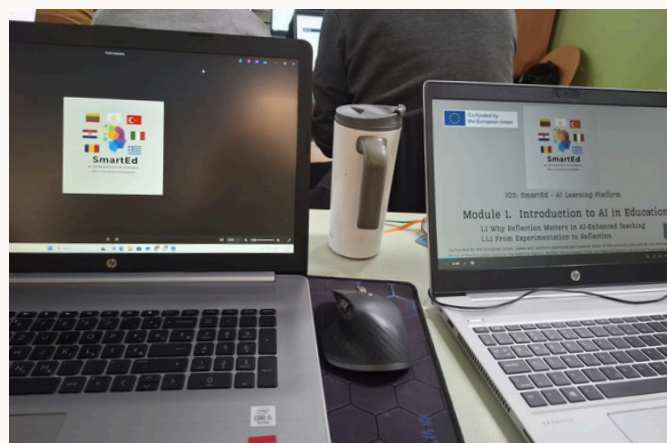
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Positive User Experience

Participants highly appreciated the platform's clear structure, intuitive navigation, and user-friendly design. The majority reported that the platform was easy to access and functioned smoothly throughout the piloting period.

More than 85% of respondents expressed a high level of overall satisfaction with the platform.



Supporting Teachers in the Use of AI

One of the key goals of SmartEd is to help educators confidently integrate artificial intelligence into teaching and learning. The piloting results showed that teachers felt more confident using AI tools and better prepared to apply AI-supported approaches in their classrooms. Participants also reported a stronger understanding of how AI can support inclusive and differentiated education.



Most Valued Learning Modules

Teachers particularly valued the modules focused on:

- Adaptation of AI tools for educational use;
- Collaborative learning approaches;
- Effective use of multimedia resources;
- AI-powered differentiation and inclusion.

These modules were considered especially relevant and practical for everyday teaching situations.

The successful piloting confirms that the SmartEd AI Learning Platform is a valuable resource for supporting innovative and inclusive teaching practices.
